

Beutler, and this is adopted or not adopted, I'll come back next year and give...bring a bill in that makes this distribution part of the 1059 formula consideration because that's at least a beginning. And I think just the fact that this is a consideration that we should have would be a good argument why we should have bracketed this bill because probably the introducers of this bill didn't even consider, as we changed it on Select File completely, that this should be considered in distribution of the 1059 formula. I think that would be very fair and a good solution to my concerns on this bill. So I hope that you will consider adopting this amendment of Senator Beutler's that just says that the money that they distribute should be part of the 1059 formula and would I have the time, although I do not, today I would draft another amendment that would say that money that has already been invested should be considered in part of the 1059 formula. I'd also like those individuals in the smaller areas to realize that Millard is now spending \$55,000 on staff development in order to teach and train individuals how to use the Internet. It is a complicated tool. It is something that I would gather very few individuals on this floor even know much about and they would take training to learn more about it. I will need a lot of training to learn more about it. It's not something that you just know automatically. It takes a lot of training, it takes a lot of awareness, it takes a lot of reading. So that is quite an expense for school districts. We also have \$32,000 worth of recurring on-line charges for all the Internet hookups in the Millard district. I would like a gavel, please. Madam Chairman.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Witek.

SENATOR WITEK: I would like a gavel, please.

SENATOR WITEK: I would at least like people to understand what the Beutler amendment is about. We have \$32,000 worth of on-line charges, recurring charges every year. There is \$200,000 from the Millard tax base every year from our educational service units that we pay to support the system that we have in Millard right now. For those smaller areas of Nebraska I would say that that should at least be a consideration in your mind when you are mandating now that they go ahead and put this into every one of their schools. This is
