PRESIDENT ROBAK: The bill does not pass with the emergency clause attached. The question before you now is, shall LB 860 pass with the emergency clause stricken? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2739 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays on the passage of 860 without the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 860 passes with the emergency clause stricken. LB 860A.

CLERK: (Read LB 860A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 860A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2739-40 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 13 nays, 3 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 860A does not pass with the emergency clause. The question before you is, shall LB 860A pass with the emergency clause stricken? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2740 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 6 nays, 8 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 860A passes with the emergency clause stricken. Mr. Clerk, we have a motion?

CLERK: Madam President, LR 3 was considered on Final Reading yesterday by the Legislature. At that time it failed to receive the necessary votes for placement on the primary election ballot. Pursuant to that action, Senator Withem moved to reconsider. That motion is now pending.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Withem to open on his motion.
