

way or another, any way I can, the 25,000 because the dean is now hired and it is time for them to continue to plan on the growth, on the comeback, if you wish. And with that I would like...maybe I could ask the Chair for a ruling. Madam President, if, in fact, would it be your understanding that if the Chambers amendment were agreed to, would another senator be able to offer a motion to override the Curtis 25,000 dollar veto, or would that be repeating the same motion twice at the same level of debate?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bernard-Stevens, yes, a senator would be allowed to offer that portion that was not adopted. It would be an appropriate motion before the body.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay, then, in that case, I may, in fact, then support the Chambers amendment because it would actually divide the question per se, but whether the Chambers amendment is adopted or not, I will be supporting in any way I can the 25,000 dollar override of the monies needed for the Curtis institution.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Will. There are no further lights. Senator Chambers, to close on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, my intent in offering this motion is not to get a vote on Curtis at all. It's just to take this one item because I want to be able to vote to override on Beatrice, and the Curtis motion can be offered. See, the debate has not been so much on the merits of either one of these or both of them, it has been on these procedural items and once those are out of the way today we don't have to go through all of this tomorrow because there won't be a motion by any...I meant a mo...a request by anybody to divide the question. We'll get at the same thing but a different way and it won't result in all this discussion and we'll have a discussion of each one of the items that will be offered. But on this one, unless there are enough votes to take them both together then I think we ought to separate Curtis out like this. This vote is not a vote as to whether or not Curtis should be funded. And, Senator Maurstad, if there are enough votes for Beatrice without mine, and I hope there will be, then that override will occur. And if Senator Wehrbein has read the body correctly, there will be enough votes to take them both as a package and there will be the 30 votes to
