

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Voc Rehab.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars was vetoed out and it was not felt by the committee that that was significant enough to be overridden. That must be true, right, since it wasn't included in the package?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, as a significant amount of money, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Was it the feeling of the committee that sufficient is being done in the area of Voc Rehab?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well originally we put in...this is additional money. This represents additional spending. See this does not cut the program at this point. I don't remember if there's even additional money left in there, there might be, but we did not reduce the program. This was additional money. We wanted to match federal money.

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I understand, but we do have additional people who need these services...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...on an ongoing basis. So even if we hold the program at the same amount of money, it doesn't mean that there will be people unserved who need the services, is that correct?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and I won't continue because my time is just about up at this point.
