CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return and record your presence. Unauthorized parties leave the floor. Senator Hall, do you wish to begin with your closing?

SENATOR HALL: I will wait a couple of minutes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. We are waiting the return of members. Please, members, you are to be in your desk, record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Warner, could you check in please. Senator Schimek, could you check in please. Senator Bromm, or Brown, excuse me, both of them have now at this point. Senator Lindsay, Senator Pirsch. Senator Hall, you have three minutes left. We are waiting for Senators Lindsay and Pirsch.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President. Then I will proceed as those members are coming to the floor. The proposal as it is offered to you includes three areas. It includes the additional probation staff, the Voc Rehab monies, and the domestic violence monies. It is a one year proposal in that it mirrors the committee's recommendation. It is for '95-96. It is a 1.6 million dollar cost in terms of the override, which brings the total override in the package to 8.5 million; 8.5 million, when you add it to the 3 million that is included in the salary proposal, which I intend to support and I believe we should, as well, you are looking at an override of approximately, what do we end up here with? We end up with approximately \$44 million. You subtract the 11, the \$12 million, you are looking at \$32 million of the Governor's vetoes that are sustained. And in the process with this proposal, we are able to garner \$2.8 million, almost \$2.9 million of federal funding in a very, very I think much needed program in the area of the Voc Rehab. I want to thank the committee. I don't do this lightly, and I understand the hard work that they have to do to make these tough decisions, but I believe that this proposal is a fair one. I don't know if you were listening but Senator Chambers said that his concerns go away with the adoption of this amendment. Now you may not want to put this proposal to bed and adopt this amendment and vote on the committee package and have this done before we recess for lunch, but I would like to, and I think it
