

this bill addresses. I think we need the measures dealing with how we handle prisoners while they're incarcerated, the change in the good-time provisions and earning the good time, but the implementation date on those, on that part of the bill is not till the middle of '96 anyway. If you pass the bill, you're going to face some people being charged this fall, September, October, November, December area, when this bill becomes law who are going to possibly be charged under a law that may or may not be constitutional or may or may not be void and I think that's...I just don't want the responsibility for putting that burden on the courts and on law enforcement. I don't think it's good business and if people want to be critical of us for being more deliberate in the way we pass this, then they just have to do that. I pulled the news releases...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...I pulled the news releases out from when 507 was passed and it's almost comical to read that and then versus the position being taken now. If...507 is on the books. We put it there, we passed it. In my way of thinking the way I generally do business we have to follow it until we repeal it or until a court says that it's unconstitutional. Six and a half months or so we can take this bill up. We can refine it a bit, put the sections back in that people want in that aren't there, fine-tune it, get the A bill rolling with it and I think we will have done better work than if we hastily pass the bill today, and I don't do that...I don't take this position easily, and I appreciate Senator Lindsay's work and all the others who have worked on the bill, and it's not the Governor, it's not the Attorney General, that's irrelevant.
