

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Wehrbein, your...yours become the committee amendments? And where is yours?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I passed it out. There's a copy. I...apparently it's not in the Journal, but I had passed it out earlier, Senator Beutler.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, if I may, the committee amendments are on page 2016. Okay. And Senator Wehrbein's amendment, as he has indicated, it's passed out. You will find it as reference to AM2598 on your desk. AM2598.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And his amendment is an amendment to the committee amendments?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Chambers, to speak to the Wehrbein amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, I had had a number of discussions with Senator Wehrbein and others who were interested in this resolution and he did hand out the final version as it would appear with his amendment and I do support his amended version. SENATOR CHAMBERS: The way this will work, if what you're offering now, which is called an amendment to the committee amendment, is adopted, that will then create the form of the resolution that you and I had talked, and you gave me a copy of.
