

Newspaper articles, magazines, books on library shelves, college professors, anybody who discusses what constitutes Nazi propaganda is in violation of this because Nebraska condemns all such people who do those things. So whether you're a publishing house, a newspaper, a seller or distributor of newspapers, you are condemned. So as far as what the Nazis have done, I won't even give a comment with reference to my attitude about that but, as bad as that guy is who is doing these things and the terrible things that he has said, I'm still never going to support a resolution of that kind. As far as the one we're on now and "Wife Witek", I guess I should say "Witek Withem", reminded me that the resolution before us does relate to the issue of Taiwan but there is nothing I have to say on that because I've already expressed my agreement. But not having had the opportunity to say anything in response to Senator Crosby, I had to kind of tailgate on Senator Wehrbein's resolution and I'm sure that, having given him my support and kind of worked with him in getting it into this form that we all accept, he is not offended that I would ride his horse because we're going to take it all the way across the finish line, Senator "Witek Withem".
