SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, there was a time when there were individuals in this Legislature who were designated liberals. That day is long gone. An article came out the other day about him being forced to disband an organization, well, a company, between himself and two lawyers who practice before the Workers' Comp Court. They claim that their organization was a nonprofit setup. But as it turned out they put on these seminars, as they're called, dealing with the business of the court or the type of business that comes before the court, profits were generated, gifts were given to the Workers' Comp Court. And I haven't heard a single senator on the floor come in here and say, something needs to be done about the Workers' Comp Court. Not one. During the instance with Larry Myers, when they were trying to figure out what to do with him, the commission had advice from a representative of the Attorney General's Office to take one of the actions they took. But I don't see anybody saying, attack the Attorney General's Office. Because those are white men. White men. And you don't want to discriminate against white men, the angry white male because he is so discriminated against. And I have to admit I feel sorry for them. You only got the President of America, which is the strongest position of the strongest country in the world. These discriminated against white men control the U.S. Senate, control the U.S. House, the U.S. Supreme Court, legislatures throughout the country, the vast majority of mayorships, city councils, county boards, county attorneys, attorneys general, judges, everywhere.
