SENATOR WITEK: Okay. Well, I appreciate the opportunity to discuss this. At this time, I will pull my amendment because I guess it really...if this bill is going forward and you want this in there, I won't get the votes to pull it out anyway, but I do appreciate the opportunity to discuss it on the floor of the Legislature and have some of my questions answered. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Witek. The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Warner. AM2678, Senator. (See page 233 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to open on his amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this changes the effective date to effective date that was in the bill, obviously, reflected last session which was, and I don't have it in front of me here, in October I believe of 19...October 1 of 1995, if I remember correctly, and this makes the effective date August 1, I believe, 1996. But it's the usual motion that we need to make on carry-over legislation to update the effective date.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there any discussion of the Warner amendment? Seeing none, Senator Warner, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Warner amendment to the committee amendments to LB 886. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, further amendments?

CLERK: Senator Chambers, I have in front of me AM2429, Senator. Believe that was the one you discussed this morning. (See
