PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..we started out that morning. Any time an opportunity presents itself for us to do good, we ought to do good. And it's not going to hurt us to do good. Good can never result in anything but a multiplication and expansion of that which is good. And if we do only those things that are easy, we have not done anything really worthy of praise. I hope that you will vote for this amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, to close on his amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, if a person wants to persevere and survive in a hostile environment for a long, long time and never burn out and never become stressed out, that person must believe in the rightness of whatever it is he or she is doing. You can determine whether a person has true moral value by whether or not he or she will give the self to principle. If that is done, then we can accord that person moral worth. But if we come to an area and we know that our fellow citizens are being harmed, there is no question about it, they are being harmed and they are being harmed in a way that is unjust, unfair and contrary to the announced principles of this state, we, who are the elected representatives, have an obligation to correct that situation. Now if I were to do the things that I do because I thought that there would be praise and support, I would have quit a long time ago. But I know that virtue is always on the gallows while villainy sits the throne. No righteous cause stays one forever, so those people who are determined to try to do right know that they will always be in a battle and, because of that, they never burn out. If, on the other hand, you thought that because a cause is just it will prevail in the short run and you do everything available to you at that time to do it and it does not produce justice, you are so crushed, so disappointed you
