SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, I am, because I think maybe we could do a little bit better, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schimek, if what Senator Warner and even you have said that it is impossible to balance this commission, why will you agree to leave this language in, and I am not trying to be argumentative, I am just asking for your opinion.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I was just drafting an amendment that I think might...might satisfy you and it would simply take out the words "and attempt to balance." In other words it would say, the Governor shall consider representation based on political affiliation, gender, race. I don't know if that gets at what you're getting at or not. I don't want to take these categories
