These, I think, are worthwhile amendments that are being offered, and, Senator Crosby, I hate to have a bill that I dislike so much where I am offering amendments that are serious amendments that might improve the bill or clarify it. I feel much more comfortable when I can just reach out in everywhere or nowhere, just pull anything out of the air that I want to and write it and send it up there, and argue for a few minutes. This is a serious amendment, and with Senator Warner's comments having been made, I don't know of anything further that I need to say on the amendment, and since I am not in my mode of just trying to stop the bill at all costs right now, this will constitute my close. Unless there is somebody else to speak, I can't cut them off.
