

indicated a number of times, does give the Office of Governor a little more input than what they have now, but there still is significant safeguard for political influence with the fixed term, removal only for cause, and the fact that the only position that a Governor can change without cause is who the Governor designates to serve as chairman. But if that change, it still, is done, then it still must come from the remaining six members. So that's a fairly narrow flexibility there. But I would hope, in any event, the body would adopt the amendment so that those who have an interest in it can begin to look at the bill in that form.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Warner. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 886. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. 'e're voting on the amendments, the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Madam President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have with respect to LB 886, Senator Chambers would move to bracket the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Chambers, to open on your bracket motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this is not a motion that brackets the bill to a day certain, but it attempts to bracket it. And although this may be hard to believe, I still am not yet in my defeat the bill at all cost mode. As I read this committee amendment which has now been adopted and is the bill, a number of things show themselves that need much more serious consideration than some of the things have been given today, because there has not been the opportunity to maturely deliberate over them. This bracket motion would give that opportunity on General File. Those who support what is being done will want to shoot the bill on across.
