The first thing it would do is encourage others who've been similarly treated to file complaints. We saw that at the federal level. They have passed legislation which the big shots want to say will prevent frivolous lawsuits from being filed. But what they are really attempting to do is to close the doors to the courthouse, to those people who have grievances against the big shots. And when you take away from people the possibility of solving problems in a peaceable manner, they will find other means. One thing I forgot to tell you all this morning, I was talking about this group who is trying to establish what they call common law courts because they don't believe in this court system or the judges, and that the only law they have to obey is that of the constitution or some of them not even that, but what they call common law, and some saying the law of God, this may shock you. Some of those people tried to recruit me to be one of their common law judges, me, Judge Chambers. Can you hear that? Naturally, in my modesty I declined. That is not an activity that I would engage myself in, in that manner. But I certainly understand the frustration that people have, the bitterness that they feel. The irony is going to be that in this state, as in Nazi Germany, where you had a short, dark individual leading the master race, all of whom were supposed to be tall, blonde and blue-eyed, and he's...the one leading them is opposite of what they were, to see a black man in the forefront, I don't say "of" but with these people who don't like the white system. Can you feature that? And there will be people in this Legislature and in editorial offices cluck, clucking, and tsk, taking. But those same people are not willing, while there is time, while the means are available, to address problems, to do so in good faith. And when the struggles develop and all these cowardly people run for cover, oh, they'll sit in here and talk big and carry water for the Governor. But once they leave here they're like scared chickens, they want bodyguards, they're afraid to venture forth at night, any knock that comes at their door, when they're not expecting somebody, they're terrified. They got little buttons that you can...they'll put in your office so you can call for security when you get scared. Senators putting little...yeah, little buttons in your office, you can punch them and security will come running. And what will they do? If security is smart and somebody wants to get one of these senators, when the button rings security will run out the door,
