SPEAKER WITHEM: Time.

SENATOR DIERKS: ...family farm corporations.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thanks, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers, we are addressing the Hillman amendment, did you care to address that amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I'm trying to get clear on exactly what Senator Hillman is striking. Senator Hillman, would you tell me again.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes, Senator Chambers, what it does is it takes, on page 3, where the amendment says, strike beginning with "the" in line...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Excuse me, you are going to the bill, page 3.

SENATOR HILLMAN: No, I'm going to Senator Dierks amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay

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SENATOR HILLMAN: And, lines 14 through 16, Section 2, where it says, on page 3, strike beginning with "the"...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Uh-huh.

SENATOR HILLMAN: ...in line 11 through number 3 in line 14. In line 20, strike "4" and insert "3".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Um-hum.

SENATOR HILLMAN: It strikes this...it strikes the section that says, the report shall indicate the basis, if any, upon which the reporting entity claims exemption from the prohibitions contained in Article XII, Section 8 of the Nebraska Constitution. I maintain that that should stay in Senator Dierks' amendment. His amendment strikes that portion. The
