SENATOR DIERKS: I think the intent is the Secretary of State take the impetus and the initiative to do this. So it would be his responsibility then to see that it is sent out.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Where does it say that the Secretary of State has to send these out? I don't really see that in the bill. That is why I was asking the questions.

SENATOR DIERKS: Well, the Secretary of State shall notify a person...well lets see that's...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I said I am going after all of these bills. You all took my heart out on 886, so you all are going to pay, but, by me dealing with provisions of the bill. Where does it say in the bill that the Secretary of State has to send this out?

SENATOR DIERKS: It says that he has to notify the person who he has reason to believe has not filed a report. So I would think that would assume that he has got the responsibility of seeing that person gets the report to file.

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But, that is not what the law says. It doesn't say here that it has to be sent by the Secretary of State. And how will the Secretary of State know that somebody has not filed? Is he going to take every filing of everyone of these entities and lay them out and then lay back, lay out all of these forms as they come in and make sure that they match up? How is he going to determine that one has not filed?
