It takes away some of the burden from a local county attorney to find these out, which I assume right now are only doing it based on a complaint. I mean that's my sense that's what's happening. If you have comments on that, I'd be interested in that. But this is a way to get at it quickly, to know whether those that are legitimate are registered, those that aren't legitimate are also registered at least or have failed to register for whatever reason, I assume that's the reason for all of this, and I support that. Once again, I don't want to add to the paperwork that those that are doing their best to be legal, and any comments you have on that is fine, but that's where I'm coming from.
