I am not interested in more paperwork, I'm not interested in another \$10,000 to the Attorney General's Office, and I'm not interested in filling out another form. I have been told by the people in this body who make their profession of counseling people on legal issues that if someone is in violation of Initiative 300, they, at this time, can be turned in by somebody, the county attorney can be asked to prosecute, the Attorney General's Office can be asked to prosecute. And I suppose that brings up some question and I'll direct a question at Senator Dierks. Senator Dierks, do you knowingly know of anybody who is violating Initiative 300 in the state at this time? And if you do, would you please name those people who are violating Initiative 300?

SPEAKER WITH THEM: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: The answer is, no, I do not know of anybody that is violating Initiative 300. I have some suspicions, but I will not name them.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Are you interested in having me fill out another form to send to the state? Is that what we're getting at here?

SENATOR DIERKS: If I have you fill one out, Senator Schrock, I'll do the same thing myself because I'm in the same situation you are. I am also a family farm corporation, so I'll have to fill out the exact same thing you will. So I guess I favor you doing it, I favor me doing it.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Do you have a problem with asking a county attorney or the Attorney General to investigate some of those suspicions of yours?

SENATOR DIERKS: Nope.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And have you asked them to do that at this point in time?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes, I have.
