

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, let me quickly reorient you to the different sections of LB 584 as it exists now in this amendment that we're considering, and you'll recall that the amendment is now the entire bill so what stays of the amendment is the bill that goes will not be a part of the bill. There are five sections, five divisions of the amendment. The first division is roughly Sections 1 and 2 and then that part of page 3 that the Clerk read for you. That is essentially Senator Fisher's bill having to do with hunter education and expanding slightly the requirements with regard to hunter education and we will turn to that presently. I hope Senator Fisher has his light pushed. I'm going to ask each one of the introducers of these different bills to explain what their particular bill does and then we'll try to as that particular bill comes up. So Section 1 and 2 essentially is Senator Fisher's bill. That's what we're on right now. That's technically what we're debating right now. Then, in addition to that, you may want to mark your committee amendment. Basically, Sections 3 through 7, for the most part, are Senator Wehrbein's bill having to do with property owners and their... and particular special hunting rights that pertain to them. I think Senator Wickersham did have and probably still has an amendment that pertains to that particular section, but that...that will be division number two, Senator Wehrbein's bill. The third division involves the trail user fee and other trail provisions involving Sections 8, 9 and 23 and most of that has been removed into another bill. Therefore, I will have an amendment suggesting the deletion of Sections 8 and 9, which will leave only Section 23, which is basically an extension of the Trails Development Fund, and we can talk about that when we get there but there's not much left there. The fourth division has to do with Section 10 of the bill which relates to the concept of a trail coordinator. That will be... I will ask you to vote that down completely since that material has been transferred to another bill. The next division then involves...that was Section 10, the trail coordinator provision. The next division involves Sections 11 through 19...11 through 14, excuse me, and then there might be an isolated part of 19 that pertains to that, but basically that's the concept of trails, excuse me, of river assessments and that is also being dealt with in a different manner; and, therefore, I would, when we get there, I will ask you to simply vote down that division immediately without the necessity of further debate. The last basic piece then represents Senator Wickersham's LB 258, which deals with
