

SENATOR JONES: I agree with you so thanks a lot.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Any further discussion on the final section of the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Beutler to close. Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the final section to the committee amendments to LB 584. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of that component of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The final component to the committee amendments is adopted. We now turn to a discussion of LB 584. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.
