that you want. And when the acrimony develops and chaos reigns, then I also reign. And we will be tied up forever. And you can just forget any attempt that you're making to add whatever it is you want to add to that bill. I cannot envision a situation where I would be able to get 27 votes to add something to a bill that I've returned to Select File for a specific amendment. So this will not apply to me, it will apply to the rest of you all. It will apply to the Governor, it will apply to the lobbyists. It's going to take you the 30 votes, and you're not going to get them, 'cause if you got 30 votes you can suspend the rule. But if you haven't got the 30, if you've got 29, if you're in sneezing range, within coughing range, within hiccuping range, you can't quite make it. If you are stretching to your ultimate and you have to touch something to save your life, and you're one-million of a millionths of a centimeter from touching it, you still haven't touched it and you die. The absence of one vote would be more than that millionth of a millionth of a centimeter. If you don't want this amendment it's all right. But I want there to have been a discussion of it, I want the transcript to reflect that it was brought to the body's attention, that the body knew what was before it and chose to keep this requirement of the 30 vote. It will not impact on me, but it will impact on others. And I will relish the instance, and there may be more, the instances when this rule that you're insistent on changing to comply with what Senator Wickersham wants, turns around to bite you. Sometime those who dig pits for others fall into them. Right, Senator Will? A bird that soars will never be caught in a snare. If you're a Road Runner, who knows, you might escape Wiley Coyote, Senator Will, and you might not. (Laugh.) This amendment is easy to understand, so I'm offering it to you for your consideration and your rejection. But I want it clear from the record that I went over it again, and again, and again, so nobody can say they did not understand. And whenever you place an act knowingly, deliberately and intentionally, it's difficult at a future date to say you did not realize what you were doing. Many times at the beginning of a venture people cannot look to the end of it and see what is going to develop. I am able to predict with relative precision, before we even enter a session,...
