have to study them and see what I could come up with in terms of understanding, what they achieved and what their purpose is and why maybe people put it there in the first place. These changes that we are making, I want nobody to have to speculate about. I want it crystal clear that it was discussed what would be the impact of Senator Wickersham's proposal. Maybe it will not come back and bite the Legislature this session. Maybe it never will. But, there is the chance that it will. That is what I think ought to be considered. If that chance is realistic and if you can conceive of a situation where it would be necessary to get something done and it can not be done, is this form and consistency that Senator Will is talking about so important and essential that ahead of time you defeat and make impossible the achieving of something which is substantial majority. By that I mean more than the bare majority of 25 would deem necessary to be done. If you adopt my amendment, which would strike that third paragraph, what would be left could very well turn around me before the rest of the rule would bite any of the rest of you because there is a likelihood of what would be attempted as a "emergency" initiative to add something to a bill on Final Reading would be something with which I disagree. Maybe I would have been successful in engineering the killing of the bill. So, I would lose because instead of taking 30, it would only take that fewer than 30 which would support doing that. I remember, but not the details of it, a couple of sessions ago where a few senators were not going to vote for a certain proposition...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and the World Herald condemned them and hung a label on them. Senator Hall was one of them, maybe Senator Will, I don't remember who all were in... maybe Scotty Moore was in it, but that few stopped something from getting a vote that may have been necessary to put it on the ballot to be voted on. And people were upset. So, realistically what I am talking about can happen. The way is laid before you. Narrow is the way Senator Coordsen that leads to salvation and few there be that find it. Broad is the way that leads to damnation. And, there be so many on there that it would be hard for a gnat to take deep breath. I will ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote and this will be the last amendment that I will attempt on Senator Wickersham's proposal.
