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they will be asked to be voting on. There is another reason I support this as a person that files a number of amendments, on occasion I will file an amendment, the Clerk is busy, they will for some reason neglect to ask whether it is printed, I will forget to mention that and I will think that I have given notice to people and it has not been given, so I think the automatic notice is a good one. I don't know. Senator Chambers, can I just ask you a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, you may.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, Senator, just from your experience here is there ever a time when a senator would file an amendment where, for some reason that Senator would not want it published, that you can think of? Other than through doing a subterfuge and evil sorts of things?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't want to put all those adjectives to it, but, I'm aware of instances when an amendment would be filed based on timing so that it is there but others wouldn't know it is there until it actually comes up for consideration.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah, that is the only thing that I can think of, and I don't know, and thank you for that comment. I just wondered if you had given some thought to this and come up with any other rationale? That would be the only reason I would think that a person may not want this in is that they would like to be in a position of bringing up an amendment that they don't want people to know about. But, I don't think that is a good reason for not having this rule in place. I think that our members need to be informed. I would like to have it assured that anytime I file an amendment that it is out there for people, so I think this is a good rule and I plan to vote for it.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you Senator Withem. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President and members, I guess I want to ask Senator Witek a question.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Witek.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I strongly support this. I have been concerned about for a long time and not being aware of all
