SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Seeing no one further wishing to speak on the advancement of LB 414, Senator Withem, you're recognized to close.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Would waive closing.

SENATOR WILL: Closing is waived. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 414 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote yes, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 414.

SENATOR WILL: LB 414 advances. LB 414A.

CLERK: LB 414A, Mr. President, was a bill originally introduced by Speaker Withem. (Read title.) I do have an amendment, Senator, AM2721 is in front of me.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Withem.

CLERK: Page 263, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah, obviously this...is this amendment that puts Senator Schellpeper's gambling measure into this? No, it's not that one so we'll, we'll go ahead with that. Okay, the rationale for the amendment is to accommodate the board that is referenced. There was no, no board in the original LB 414 and so it appears as though this is a, will be a cash funded board, the board that Senator Bernard-Stevens was making reference to a second ago.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Withem. Any discussion on the amendment? If not, the question is the adoption of AM2721 to LB 414A. All those in favor vote yes, opposed no. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.
