CLERK: Madam President, Senator Beutler would move to amend.  
(See AM2810 on page 467 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler to open  
on his amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Coordsen, as I was looking at a  
certain section of a statute this morning for purposes of  
reviewing one of the bills I am interested in, I came across  
70-906 and 70-907; 70-907 requires a report to be refiled by  
December 31, 1988, which is long past. I checked with the  
Revisor, they have no problem, so I thought while the trash bin  
was going by, I'd toss a couple more items in, if that's al'  
right

SENATOR COORDSEN: I assume, Senator Beutler, that your  
statements are absolutely correct and I would have no objection  
to that amendment to this bill.
