Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they've examined and reviewed LB 700, recommend that same be placed on Select File; 847 Select File. Amendments to be printed, Senator Warner to LB 298A; Senator Warner to LB 886; Senator Bernard-Stevens to 624; Senator Chambers to LR 17CA. Senator Jensen has selected his priority bill, Mr. President, LB 1368. Hearing notice from Natural Resources Committee. And I have a series of adds and withdrawals: Senator McKenzie would like to add her name to 1208; Senator Chambers to 1082; Senator Will to 1368. (See pages 485-521 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.

CLERK: The next item I have with respect to LR 17CA are amendments by Senator Lindsay. Senator, I have notes, you had two amendments, you want to withdraw those two and offer AM2787, is that correct?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Yeah, the amendment is printed in the Journal, but, as I mention, it basically covers the same concept that we just talked about. Given that, and since we've had a discussion on it, had a vote on it, I think I'll lay that over then to Select File and take up that issue again as well as the issue of changing the number of days down. So, with that, I would withdraw that amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Mr. President.
