SENATOR HUDKINS: Madam President and members of the body, excuse our hesitation here, but Senator Lindsay has been unavoidably detained. The committee amendments for LB 750, let's see, the committee amendments consist of the elimination of the reference to a threatened release and also the limiting of the liability exposure. The statute of repose part was taken out. And that was taken out by the Legislature at a prior time. Forgive me, I think that's all I can add to this at this point.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, I had an amendment to the committee amendments, Senator, drafted by yourself, it's on page 2308 from last year, it strikes Sections 2 and 3 of Section, subsections (2) and (3) of Section 15.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd withdraw that, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion to the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Hudkins, to close on the committee amendments. Closing is waived.
