

January 19, 1996 LB 592

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now turn to Select File. We will pass over LB 168, LB 425, and LB 425A and turn to LB 592.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 592 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Day and Beutler. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 18 of last year. It was referred to Judiciary. The bill was advanced to General File. Committee amendments were adopted. There were several amendments on General File that was adopted. The bill was ultimately advanced and reported to Select File. The first item I have this morning are adoption or consideration of adoption of Enrollment and Review amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler, may I call on you?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I'm sorry, what is the first item on the...?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Pardon me?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review amendments. We need to adopt those and then I'll start going through the other ones.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, I'd move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments in that case, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Is there any discussion on the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments? Seeing none all those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted. Senator Beutler, if you will fill us in on where we are on LB 592, refresh us as to the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Madam President, members of the Legislature, as you all are aware, this was Connie Day's bill last year, she was the principal introducer and, frankly, did most all of the work on it. Up until the time she left the Legislature, she was working on it and aspects of it. And she
