PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...(interruption) or you lose the ability to pay your child support obligation. And I guess those are my issues and I'll, I know there's not much time, but I wanted to, I think this is an important issue that the body needs to spend a little bit of time and review. And this morning, when things happened quickly, it's probably good to slow down just a bit and allow everybody to catch up. And I'd appreciate your answers. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam President and members. Just briefly, too, Senator Kristensen voiced some of the problems I have this bill. I voted against it last spring when it moved because the visitation...I understood that the visitation requirements and so on were taken out. I see you have something in there now, Senator Beutler. I think the visitation thing is the problem that I have with the whole situation that we have here. And at least Senator Witek is zeroing in on one license and not on every license in the world that someone could have. I think when you take away a professional license in particular, and the issue is whether or not child support's going to be paid, well, there goes the income. So, I think we have to take a look at this bill and be really careful of putting something in place that's going to be unwieldy, unworkable. To go back to the visitation, I do hope that we come up with something that will end this using of the children as a tool for either side's anger against the other. They get divorced and the court sets up visitation rights for the noncustodial parent, and then the
