PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...a report, the latest report from South Dakota indicating as has been indicated in other places, that there is a very apparent and definite effect, a very positive effect. I hope you'll take a look at this handout. And also up in South Dakota, the federal district court has basically verified the procedures similar to ours do not violate equal protection provisions of the Federal Constitution, do not violate substantive due rights, substantive due process rights under the Federal Constitution, and do not violate due process provisions of the Federal Constitution, nor for that matter, of course, of the South Dakota Constitution which is, is neither here nor there to us. In any event, what I'm saying to you, it's becoming increasingly clear, although I know of no...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...definitive Supreme Court decision, it's become increasingly clear that the provisions that we're talking about are, are acceptable constitutional provisions legally.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Witek. Senator Witek.

SENATOR WITEK: Thank you. I'd kind of like to bring the discussion back to my amendment. And I'll just...I think what I'll do, since we've had such a short time kind of not knowing that this would come up, is just read it and so you can see how it simplifies the process. It allows a lot of flexibility. It allows a judge who will be hearing these cases, who will be involved in these cases to make the determination. Some people have brought up the point that it would be a hardship to remove some professional licenses. And in the case of someone who uses their driver's license for their professional license, that is definitely the case and that judge will be able to determine at that time whether it's more intelligent, makes better sense to remove the individual's license to force the support payment or to allow the individual at that time to keep their license so that the support payment is paid and at least give an opportunity for, you know, that second chance.
