PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Witek. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. I want to visit a little bit about the whole issue of child support as it relates to this bill and to Senator Witek's amendment. One is I think that the body also needs to, and, Senator Beutler, please correct me if I'm wrong, but I believe this bill also goes to spousal support. So when we talk about child support, this also includes alimony awards, and I think maybe even...does it go to some of the medical awards as well? But at least it does go to spousal awards, is that correct?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...alimony insofar as it's awarded along with child support would be subject to this bill. Alimony that's completely separate and doesn't involve a decree including child support would not be affected by this bill.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: You're going to have to help me with that. I...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Alimony...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Let's...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Alimony...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I don't want to use myself because I...I feel I'll jinx myself, so let's just say that...let's say Senator Cudaback is involved in a divorce decree and he has an order entered for child support and then, because he's making a lot and his spouse is not and she's given up some time to stay at home and so on, she's given an alimony award. There's two separate figures. Are both of those figures collectable under this procedure? Or if he pays his child support but doesn't pay his alimony, can you revoke his license to be a plumber or whatever, because he doesn't pay his alimony?
