

Cost-effective is a big difference. And then I'll have the information I need to determine that, and then to see whether we need to change it or revoke it or do whatever we need to do with it. But you can't do that with simply one report that tells you how many licenses have been revoked. So I'd like to enhance that report. I don't think it will be a burden. And if they're spending the money,...

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR WITEK: ...(interrupted)...to tell us where they're spending it. This falls on the Director of Social Services. They'll probably be spending the bulk of the money. And if they even have to estimate, if we need some legislative intent here, if they even have to estimate in some areas I understand that. But I want a little more, I want to know a little more than how many licenses they pulled. I want to know how much it has cost to implement, and I want to know if we have, in fact, increased our child support payments. So I would ask for your support of this amendment to begin to ask for really the information that we'll need to determine the effectiveness of this piece of legislation in this report that this piece of legislation asks for, not a report that I've asked for. Thank you.
