SENATOR WITEK: You can go ahead, I don't need to get everybody up here. This will be fine, thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We'll take a machine vote on the Witek amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Lindsay, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR LINDSAY: I'd ask for a roll call vote, regular order.

SPEAKER WITHEM: A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 532-33 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is rejected. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Revenue, Chaired by Senator Warner, reports LB 1041 to General File; LB 921, General File with amendments; LB 1122, General File with amendments. Hearing notice from the Judiciary Committee. Senator Witek would like to print...has amendments to LB 592 to be printed. And Senator Lynch would like to add his name to LB 1013; Senators Elmer, Witek, Dierks to LB 1347; Senator Robak to LB 1347; Senator Jensen to LB 1206; Senator Witek to LB 1368. Senator Beutler, Mr. President, would like to add his name to LB 592A as coinroducer. And one final report. Revenue Committee reporting LB 1121 to General File. That's all that I have.
