SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

Remember we are talking about a situation and only the situation where a person's license has unjustifiably been lifted, only where unjustifiably that has done, been done, only in the instance where the action of the state, its agents or flunkies has resulted in harm to an innocent person. And, Senator Beutler, we are not talking about those who haven't paid their child support, we are talking about those who, based on the criteria established in this law, were unfairly punished under this law.

SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And, it is not enough to say, I'm sorry. Madam President, I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There is a request for a call of the house. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record please.
