If this happens and my professional license gets pulled, whether I'm a real estate person, a doctor, a lawyer, a truck driver, anything that would affect my income, and you have gone ahead and pulled that and I don't have that income. So even if I wasn't originally in arrears, I will now be in arrears because you pulled my opportunity to make any money to be able to pay for my child support of which I was paying very timely on, and you have caused this destruction in my cash flow, in my family, we all know how that can damage families because the whole reason for this bill is because we're saying that it damages families. Then we have to admit if you're willing to go with this approach, if you're willing to allow this to happen, then you have to be willing to pay for your mistakes and you have to be willing to help out those families that are affected by those mistakes. So I'm not going to say it's going to happen a lot, but even if it happens once it's still going to hurt a family, and it's going to hurt a reputation and someone's business. And we should be, we should be up front about admitting that we know this will happen at least once and saying, when it happens, just renewing their license isn't good enough. What we're going to have to do is allow that person to put their life back together, put their business back together, and do whatever we can to help that happen because if you want, one, and that's to increase child support payments and the way that you're going to do this
