SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk, read the amendment please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the Lindsay amendment by striking the language requiring that Section 25 be stricken, and add after the period in line 21 on page 12 the following new language, "Each respective report shall include the number and type of license erroneously suspended or revoked."
