

And it has the potential to impact a lot of families here in Nebraska. So it is important that we take the time to discuss these changes thoroughly. And what my amendment did at the time, this is the exact same amendment with one small change. There was a concern that I wasn't specific enough on the Department of Social Services, on exactly what was expected of them. So the amendment that you're being passed out this morning is almost exactly the same as the amendment that I started on my three-page amendment that would taken all the original sections of 592 out and inserted this amendment. And the only change that I have made since that time is that it's saying "in situations within the Department's authorization". So instead of just saying in all situations that arise with the license revocation, this just says that the Department of Social Services will only be addressing, in situations within...it's on the first page, paragraph 3...or number 3 of Section 1. It says, in situations within the departments authorization to allow the Department of Social Services to communicate to individuals who are not in compliance with a support order, the potential for impoundment of their motor vehicle operators' license. So they don't have to notify everybody, because they obviously are not aware of everyone who is in arrears on their child support payments. But just those individuals who are within their awareness, who are within their compliance, that's the individuals that they will have to notify that they are not in compliance with their support order, and there's the potential for having their motor vehicle operators' license removed. The differences in my amendment and 592 are vast. I admit that there's...there's...really, to me, 592 is an administrative nightmare for a large county, like Douglas County. You have people within our county that have come to most of our senators, if not all of our senators, and told us that they do not want this bill to pass at all, they do not want this bill to pass at all. But I think most of us realize that we are at a low compliance level on our child support collections, 20 percent by the figures of the individuals who are behind 592. And I would like to see an increase in that, because I do understand that those individuals need to be responsible and need to be paying their child support. And the people who are not getting the child support, who are then dependent on the entitlements for the state are straining these entitlement programs in this state. There's a lot of money that's going out. So it would help the situation there, and I do want to improve that collection. So I think that's...we can
