SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Beutler, I have a problem with CDL license. Is CDL license the same as a drivers license, or is it a different license altogether?

SENATOR BEUTLER: CDL stand ng for commercial drivers license, right?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Right, um-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, it would be, as we have this structured, it would still be a part of the drivers revocation section, so it would still be included in the bill.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, if this is...I would say that that would be a professional license. Do they have another drivers license along with the CDL license? You know, if they would pull the CDL license would they still have a drivers license?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I believe that they would...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...or would they have to pull both?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I believe that they would, but I need to verify that for you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: You know, I'm concerned about that, if that actually is that person's professional license. I've had.... Thank you, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: In my opinion I believe we are getting a little closer to what may be palatable for some of the people who are on the fence here. I have had several calls in the evening about this legislation. And after visiting with those particular people I asked them, you know, who is going to pay? Who is going to pay if the person doesn't pay? I said, are you willing to pay your share then for someone who does not pay the child support? Well, definitely not. Well, I said, you are whether you know it or not, because every taxpayer in the state is paying for the person who does not pay the child support. I also have another problem with the child support that is paid, that we don't seem to be addressing here. So often the child
