Nineteen percent opposed, 21 or 81 percent supported the concept. So I think that we all are interested in curing this problem of delinquent child support. I think this is one way. I also have another thought on it. It may be something that we may want to look at it perhaps on Select File, if we're lucky enough to get there, that we should look at a sunset on this. Oh, I'm sorry, at Final Reading, okay. And...but...in order...I'm not going to offer amendment to do this, but perhaps a sunset should perhaps be considered. And if it does work, as some of us think it will, then we can continue. But if it doesn't, if it does create the problem that some of us believe it will create, we can then abandon this idea. But I think it's a solution that has to be tried. The other states seem to be very successful in it. And I would really support this. Hopefully we can eliminate the problem of these children not being paid their dues. It's really a tough question. And I really have some problem with not being able to attack...just attach only drivers' license when I think it should be all folks, all peoples in this state should be subject to it. But I will support Senator Beutler's amendment. Thank you.
