SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, reluctantly Madam President, I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a call of the house, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Coordsen, will you check in please. Senator Pirsch, will you check in please. Senator Schrock, Senator Schellpeper and Senator Janssen. Senator Beutler has requested a roll call vote. The question before you is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the Witek amendment to LB 592. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. Vote appears on page 555 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Beutler amendment is adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Madam President, if I may, hearing notice from the Banking Committee and the Retirement Systems Committee. Senator Pedersen has selected LB 575 as his priority bill for this session. Senator Wickersham has amendments to be printed to LB 847. Retirement Systems reports LB 378, indefinitely postponed; LB 419, indefinitely postponed; LB 521, indefinitely postponed; LB 594, indefinitely postponed; LB 844, indefinitely postponed. LB 1072 is offered by Business and Labor is advanced to General File. Transportation reports LB 938 and LB 1073 to General File. That is all that I have Madam President. PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We return to LB 592. Mr. Clerk, motions on the bill.

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to reconsider.
