

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, this is a motion which I may not carry all the way to a vote. But, I'll tell you what I will suggest and this statement will include everybody who voted for that amendment including Senator Beutler. I'll bet there are people who don't know what is in this amendment. Let me ask Senator Schrock a question. Senator Schrock, I would like to ask you a question on this amendment, and this is not to ask you what is in it but to get your opinion so that it is within the realm of what you would know. When based on the requirements of this amendment, if a person loses his or her license and then does whatever is necessary to comply with this order, this is the language we find on page 8, starting in line 6, "When a license holder comes into compliance with the support order as provided in Section 13 of this Act, the department, county attorney or authorized attorney shall provide the license holder with written confirmation that the license holder is in compliance." Now we are coming to the part that I want to ask you about. "Upon presentation by the license holder of a written confirmation of compliance to the Department of Motor Vehicles, the license holder, (blank) have his or her operators license reinstated upon payment of the fee." Do you think when a person comes into compliance it should be mandatory that the department reinstate his or her license or should it be left up to the department whether they will do so or not.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, if they come into compliance I think they should get their license back.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, then why did you vote to say that the license holder "may" have his or her operator's license reinstated instead of "shall". Why did you vote to say that they "may" but not "shall" because all the other language is "shall".

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, I don't have a good answer for that one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Did you realize that was in the amendment?

SENATOR SCHROCK: No, I did not.
