

responsibility. The responsibility for seeing that child support is paid is diffused, and I want to spell it so whoever types it gets it right, d-i-f-f-u-s-e-d. Among too many people and agencies under Senator Witek's amendment we have one judge and if that judge does not handle it properly we have recourse where that judge is concerned and responsibility can not be shifted and palmed off on somebody else. We don't have to waste a lot of time. We don't have to start where the bones are located on the prairie and back track like Pecos Bill can do to the point where the critter was born and determine its ancestry and so forth. We don't have to go through all of those steps. We know the judge who gave the order. We have the basis for the order in that proceeding in that judges court. And, we can determine if favoritism is being shown toward some or oppression towards others. If those who are at the bottom of the barrel are hit with a hammer and those who are considered at the top are given lenient treatment we have one person and one person only accountable and we can identify that person. With this complex procedure that Senator Beutler has persuaded you all to adopt, you don't know at what point along this chain a breakdown occurred. You will never know. And, if you tried to work things through the SS Department and I mean Schutz Staffel, Senator Jensen, S-c-h-u-t-z S-t-a-f-f-e-l, it goes by the letters SS, that was Hitler's bodyguard, a special police force. That agency is like the catacombs and a labyrinth rolled into one. Finding your way through it is a practical impossibility. Why, since we say we are facing the issue of obtaining enforcement of child support orders, are we going to complicate it? You have, under Senator Witek's amendment, and by the way, if we reject Senator Beutler's amendment on this reconsideration motion, and we adopt Senator Witek's amendment, since you are going to take licenses, I would then make a motion to reinstate professional licenses because we have a judge who is going to rule on all of these matters that are involved in the issue and you don't have the mixture of gold over here and clay over there, meaning that the court does its work, then it is turned over to bureaucrats where there is no accountability and no responsibility and a number of links in a chain.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With the judge presiding there would be the opportunity to raise all the issues involved in taking the license or avoiding having the license taken. And remember,
