I asked you the question simply because I wanted to know if you would continue to oppose anything that came up for this purpose, just to stall the bill out and get rid of it or if you are willing to try to come up with something that we can deal with and do what basically this would do in some manner. Now I'm not suggesting this is the right manner. I'm suggesting that there should be a way to get it done and I'm in favor of getting it done in making some of these people who are not taking care of the responsibility that I think is theirs, in some degree there may be some inequities dealt, I've got some letters from fathers telling me how they only get ten percent of the time with their kids and yet they have got to pay, they have got to pay such an exorbitant amount of money for child support. I don't know if that is right or not. I'm not going to enter into that debate this morning. But I am saying again the magnitude of this bill and the thickness of this bill and be able to absorb it in the short of time that we had to do it, I think is unfair to the body and I hope that we don't have to go through these kind of exercises in order to get this kind of legislation passed. With that I am merely explaining it to you because I voted for the bill because I think it is a good idea to get it done, but I'm not sure this is the right way. With that, thank you very much Madam President.
