

hearing, an opportunity to pay and all of these other things, but you don't do part of it at Situs A and part of it at Situs B, part of it at Situs C and they don't even have to be coordinated. Leave it in the courtroom of the judge who impose the order to pay. That is the first thing. The order is entered. All the disputes about the amount and so forth can be handled by that judge. Once an amount is settled on, the individual who is ordered to pay must pay. Then if a set of circumstances arises, where that person is not paying, then that person comes back to the same judge and the judge lets that person know that among the means that I can make you pay is the lifting of your license. If you say that you don't want your license lifted because you need it to earn a living, and your job is such that you can not afford to be in jail, I'm going to be lenient with you and I'm going to take you at your word, even though you haven't done the right thing. I'm going to let you set up a payment plan, I'm going to let you keep your license since you need it in your work and I'm going to let you, as of this day, tell us that you are going to pay this amount and you better pay it. And then once we get you on your feet we are going to make you pay more as your able to pay more. And if you don't, the next time you come in here either you are going to jail or your license is gone. All of that can be done by the same judge. That is not unreasonable. We can get rid of talk about creating a cause of action for the inappropriate taking of somebody's license. We don't even have to talk about what I discussed as to whether you should have the word "may" or the word "shall" when a person license is to be reinstated because he or she came into compliance. We don't have to come up with a new definition of child support. We don't have to clean up a lot of the language that needs to be cleaned up in this bill and the questions that Senator Robinson didn't get answered won't even be before us any more. All of that goes away. What are we left with? We are left with a situation where a judge's order is enforced the way all judge's orders are enforced by the judge with this change. We give the judge an additional hammer to use and Senator Vrtiska, Senator Cudaback, Senator Robinson and others who have followed this second discussion that we are having should vote to reconsider. We should reject the Beutler amendment. We should adopt the Witek amendment. I told her a couple of small little adjustments I would like to make to hers.
