SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Hillman amendment to LB 584. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Hillman's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I move to advance LB 584 to E & R for enrollment.
