Affairs Committee; from Business and Labor Committee. (See pages 608-09 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. LB 414 is the next bill.

CLERK: Madam President, 414, Senator, I have E & R first of all.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 414.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 414. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: First amendment I have, Madam President, is by Senator Withem. Senator, AM2762 in front of me.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, Madam President and members of the body, AM2762 is this lengthy document that was placed on your paper about an...on your desk about an hour ago. In some ways the way this came down was...it was somewhat of a mistake, but it's okay. We should still go ahead and adopt this anyway. We had requested that Bill Drafters' Office run a white copy of the bill so the parties that were interested in the advanced registered nurse practitioner bill would be able to see it in its full context. What happened upstairs was they did that plus made a couple of other technical sorts of changes regarding we had, for instance, had made a change in one portion of the statute but had not made that same change elsewhere, so that's contained within here. But what 2762 is, is a white copy of the bill. Normally I would not be offering this as an amendment, it's something that we work with on the side to help people understand what the bill will look like. But because the next set of amendments are adopted to this, and because there were two or three clerical cleanup things that were included by Bill Drafters along with the white copy of the bill, we need to adopt this first and then the next set of amendments are also relatively technical so, but we'll get to those, but that's what this amendment does.
