SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 414 to E & R for engrossment.
