

January 25, 1996 LB 642A

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Avery.

SENATOR AVERY: I, which one, what was that number?

CLERK: Well, I have 2895 that's been withdrawn, but now I have in front of me the amendment that has some panned in numbers that I assume is the one you want to take up. (See FA405 on page 617 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR AVERY: Right, that's the one.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Avery.

SENATOR AVERY: This, with the change of date, again, we had to do some adjusting in terms of numbers. Over a two-year period there is still going to be some cost savings. I don't know, the numbers have jumped around considerably. I think the Fiscal staff has come up over the two years about, right now what they have is about a \$42,000 savings over the two, over the two-year period. I would ask that you support this amendment so we can move the A bill with the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Avery. There's an Avery amendment pending to LB 642A. Any discussion? Seeing none, any close. Senator Avery? Closing's waived. The question is the adoption of the Avery amendment to LB 642A. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Avery's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 642A to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All of those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?
