

within a reasonable time after you are stopped is probative of driving under the influence offense. Based on the circumstances of your arrest a prosecutor may charge you with one or more of the offenses related to driving while intoxicated, or driving under the influence of any alcoholic liquor, or drugs, or whether you take a test or refuse to take a test. The criminal penalties for refusal are the same as if you were driving under the influence if you're convicted for refusal. Such offenses included (a) driving under an illegal concentration of alcohol in your blood, breath, urine, or driving under the influence of any alcoholic liquor or drugs. A first conviction is a Class W misdemeanor, it carries with it a mandatory minimum penalty of seven days imprisonment or a \$200 fine. The maximum penalty is 60 days imprisonment or a \$500 fine. In addition, the court shall order you not to drive and shall revoke your license for a period of six months. A second conviction is a Class W misdemeanor and carries a mandatory minimum penalty of 90 days imprisonment and a \$500 fine. In addition, the court shall order you not to drive a motor vehicle and shall revoke your license for a period of one year. A third conviction is a Class W misdemeanor and carries with it a mandatory minimum of 90 days imprisonment and a \$500 fine. The maximum penalty is one year imprisonment and a \$500 fine, Senator Stuhr. In addition, the court shall order you not to drive a motor vehicle and revoke your license for a period of 15 years. A fourth or subsequent conviction is a Class W misdemeanor and carries with it a mandatory minimum penalty of one year imprisonment and a \$500 fine. The maximum penalty is five years imprisonment and a \$10,000 fine. In addition, the court shall order you not to drive a motor vehicle and revoke your license for a period of 15 years. The operation of a motor vehicle while under suspension is a separate crime. (c) There are more serious penalties, including felonies, which could result from a test disclosed to do all of those illegal concentrations of drugs or alcohol.
